Submission Guidelines

Dear colleagues and friends,

from January 25th, 2024 it will be possible to apply for the participation to the 10th edition of the Seminar on International and Comparative Labour Law that will be held at Ca' Foscari University of Venice (Italy), under the direction of Prof. Adalberto Perulli and Prof. Tiziano Treu.

The seminar is addressed to legal scholars, graduate students and experts specialized in international labour law and labour law. English language skills will be essential in order to participate. As there are max 30 places available, priority will be given to early applicants.

The total cost of the seminar is 1000 Euro + IVA (Vat) (22%) = 1220 Euro, which include accommodation (Check-in June 2^{nd} - Check-out June 6^{th} , 2024 in a university residence, in a single room with private bathroom), breakfast, meals and administration.

Call for scholarships

ISLSSL Scholarships

With a view to promoting the study of labour law and social security among legal scholars, we are starting the selection process in order to grant six scholarships (1,000 Euro each) which will include accommodation (Check-in June 2^{nd} - Check-out June 6^{th}), in a university residence, in a single room with private bathroom, breakfast, meals and administration expenses.

Requirements:

1. Only applicants coming from countries other than Italy are eligible.

2. Maximum age of forty (40) years old: preference will be given to those aged less than 35 years old.

3. Those who have benefited from a grant from the ISLLSS are not eligible.

4. Scholarship winners must write a paper for the Young Scholars' Session of the Seminar. The papers will be examined for a publication.

5. Furthermore, each scholarship winner must submit to the International Society of Labour Law and Social Security a report on its activities and contents, within 30 days of the seminar conclusion.

6. Both sexes are equally welcome, but female applicants are encouraged.

7. Applications must be submitted to the national association of labour law and social security pertaining to the country of the applicant, accompanied by the applicant's curriculum vitae, motivations for participating to the seminar, research interests, university affiliation and other elements and requirements that the national association considers relevant. The same application must be sent in copy to islssl@unive.it. <u>Applications for ISLSSL scholarships must be submitted by 1st April 2024.</u>

8. In order to ensure the widest scholarships international distribution, ISLSSL will grant one scholarship to each country. If the national association should get more than one application, a selection procedure will start, based on merit and experience, (set by each national association). If none of the applicants are eligible, the selection will be declared unsuccessful.

9. <u>National associations must notify ISLSSL by 5th April 2024 the name, CV and other information provided by the applicant that has been selected</u>. In the event the number of applicants nominated by national associations is larger than the total number of scholarships available (6), ISLSSL - through the International Scientific Committee of the Seminar - will select the six applicants. This Committee will have a maximum of 10 days to identify the six applicants that will receive the scholarships. The decision is final and cannot be appealed.

We invite the ISLLSS national associations to immediately open the call for the respective scholarship, establishing deadlines and places for applications that will give the appropriate time for the selection, and to communicate the decision to the ISLLSS within the deadline.

AIDLASS Scholarships

AIDLASS will grant 3 scholarships (1000 Euro each) for Italian scholars only.

Applications for AIDLASS scholarships must be submitted by e-mail at <u>islssl@unive.it</u>, attaching the applicant's CV, motivations for participating to the seminar, research interests, and university affiliation.

Applications for AIDLASS scholarship must be submitted by 1st April 2024.

Ca' Foscari Scholarships

Ca' Foscari University will award 4 scholarships (500 Euro each).

Applications for Ca' Foscari scholarships should be submitted by e-mail at <u>islssl@unive.it</u>, attaching the applicant's CV, motivations for participating to the seminar, research interests, and university affiliation.

Applications for Ca' Foscari scholarships must be submitted by 1st April 2024.

Scholarship recipients will be notified via email, by 15th April 2024.

<u>Scholarship recipients must attend the entire Seminar and must write a paper for the Young</u> <u>Scholars' Session of the Seminar.</u> In case of winning of partial Scholarship (AIDLaSS and Ca' Foscari), scholarship recipients must arrange the payment of the remaining amount of the fee.
